Thank you to all who have purchased SCRIP. We're trying to raise **\$5000 by April 30**. All profits will go toward teaching materials for the classrooms.

### PROGRAM STATUS SINCE JANUARY 26:

- ◆ 73 families participating (approximately 30% of school families)
- ◆ \$23, 200 of SCRIP purchased (approximately \$67,000/mo needed to reach our goal)
- ◆ \$1051 of rebate to the school (\$3400/month needed to reach our goal)
- ◆ 3 families have earned a \$25 rebate toward HSA fees
- ◆ 2 families have earned a \$50 rebate toward HSA fees

While this is a good start, we can definitely do better. **WE NEED YOUR PARTICIPATION.** If every family spent at least **\$100 a week** on SCRIP between now and April 30, we could easily meet our goal of raising \$5000 for the school and reimbursing you for some of your HSA fees.

### All Saints Youth Mission Trip Spring Break 2010

Greetings! As you may be aware, the **All Saints High School Youth Group** is again answering a call to be part of a very special mission trip to The Pines Catholic Camp in Big Sandy, Texas. In 2009, after the mission trip to Mexico was cancelled, the youth group helped The Pines build a new cabin for visiting Priests. Again this year, about 25 teens will be spending Spring Break at the camp with the goal of building a chapel that will be used for Mass and Eucharistic Adoration. The new chapel will accommodate 50-60 campers/retreat participants. This is an important mission as Mass and Adoration are very meaningful parts of the many retreats hosted by The Pines each year. It is exciting that our own All Saints youth ministry and many other groups will be able to use the new chapel for many years to come.

The missionary team is humbly seeking support from friends and family in two ways: prayer warriors and prayer/donor warriors. We are equally grateful for both your prayers and financial support. Our mission team of 25 teens is responsible for buying all of the materials to build the chapel, including the drywall, wiring, plumbing, windows, etc. The total cost of the chapel is \$12,550, and we are confident that, together with the prayers and support of All Saints Catholic Church and School families, we can make this happen for The Pines. 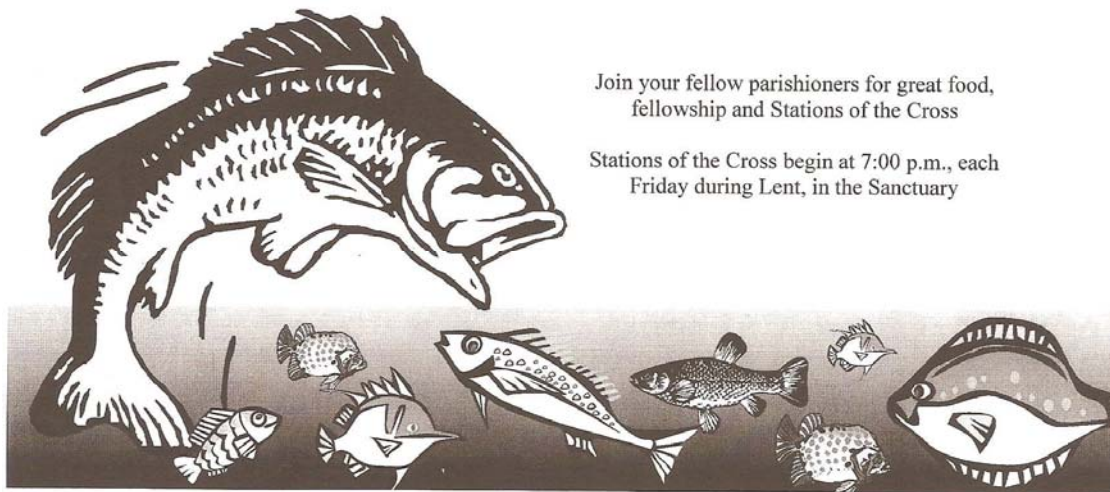

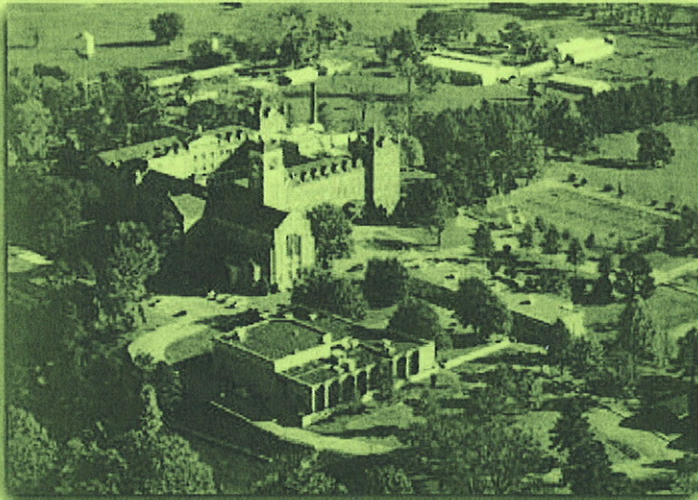

**Camp Subiaco** uses the facilities of Subiaco Academy and Abbey, including swimming pool, athletic fields, and nearby streams and lakes.

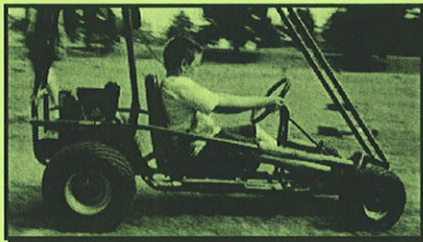

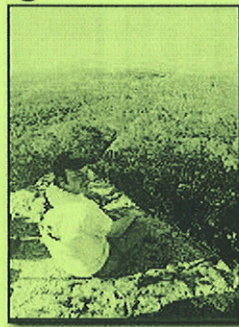
