FAQs about Scrip at ASCS

What is a Scrip gift card?

It is a gift card redeemable at any of the participating merchants. It works the same as cash. Simply stated, when you purchase a \$100 gift card through the Scrip Program for Tom Thumb, you may use it to purchase groceries just the same as cash! It is a dollar-for-dollar exchange.

What is a Scrip Gift Certificate?

You can purchase a Scrip gift certificate which allows the recipient to redeem it for any gift card in our inventory (“Scrip-to-Go”), or to special order a gift card. All cards must be picked up at the school.

What is *ScripNow!*?

ScripNow! is the quickest way to purchase scrip for you or a friend. You can order for yourself or send an eGift in seconds from various retailers. *ScripNow!* can be delivered and used in minutes simply by using *PrestoPay*, or pay by check and the items will be released by your coordinator.

How does Scrip generate revenue for the school?

The Great Lakes Scrip Center acts on behalf of churches, schools and other non-profit organizations to purchase large amounts of Scrip from grocery stores, restaurants, department stores, and other retailers. Because the Scrip is purchased with cash up-front, the participating retailers offer a substantial discount. Our school buys the Scrip from the Great Lakes Scrip Center at a discount, and resells the cards to families like yours for full face value. The discount (from 1.25 to 16%) is our organization’s revenue.

How does the revenue benefit my children at ASCS?

The profits generated from Scrip sales will go toward technology or educational materials for the classroom.

What retail gift cards are available through the Scrip program at ASCS?

The Great Lakes Scrip Center offers gift cards/certificates from more than 600 [National Retailers](#). Of these retailers, ASCS keeps about 40 of the most common gift cards on hand (“Scrip-to-Go”) for direct sale at the school.

When can I purchase Scrip from inventory (Scrip-to-Go)?

Scrip-to-Go is open in the school atrium on Tuesdays from 7:30 to 9:30am; and on Fridays from 7:30 to 9:30am, and 1:30 to 3:00pm. They can also be purchased in the school office outside of these times. Scrip-to-Go is also available at the church in the Fellowship Hall after the 9:15am and 11:00am masses on select Sundays. If your gift card is not available through Scrip-to-Go, you can order it by completing the *Special Orders* section of the Scrip Order Form.

How do I order Scrip online?

Go to www.shopwithscrip.com to create your family account. Use the ASCS enrollment code **28FD5D3D22337**.

How do I pay for Scrip?

You can pay with cash, check (made out to *ASCS HSA Scrip*), or on-line with PrestoPay™.

How does PrestoPay™ work?

PrestoPay™ allows you to order your Scrip online and pay for your order electronically by debiting your bank account. This requires a simple one-time setup process. (A 39¢ fee is deducted per transaction).

When and where can I pick up my Scrip order?

Orders submitted and paid for by 9:30am on Tuesdays will be available at the school for pick up by Friday morning of the same week. Orders can be picked up in the school atrium during Scrip sales hours or at the school office. Orders can also be delivered to your child's backpack if indicated on your order form.
